




Nursery

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Dear Parents,

The school year is fast approaching an end as we begin our final term of the school year. Our topic this half term is 'Once Upon a time...' and we will be basing our learning around traditional nursery rhymes and tales. We have already changed the role-play area to the Kingdom of Fairy Tales.

St George's Day—Monday 23rd April & St George's Dress up day— Friday 27th April

We are using the story of St George and the Dragon as a theme next week. On Monday 23rd we are having a Forest Schools St George's Day, when the children will be going to 'Knight School'. They will need to come to school in their old clothes and coat. They will need to bring their wellingtons in a bag to change into. On Friday we are having a St George's dress up day and the children can come to school dressed in the colours of the English flag, as a knight or as a princess.

The children will need to come to school in suitable clothing such as their red polo shirts, sweatshirts, jogging bottoms, and trainers, they will also need wellingtons and a waterproof coat if the weather looks inclement or sun hats if the sun is shining. Due to the nature of some of the activities the children may get dirty!
