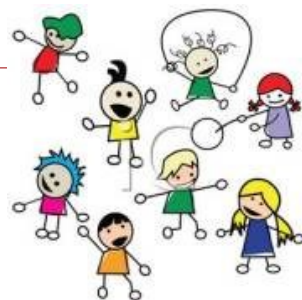

Dear Parents,

The end of the school year is fast approaching, and the September start children are nearing the end of their time in Nursery. In the next few weeks all the children will be meeting their new teachers and visiting their new classrooms. Whilst starting school full time is exciting, it can also be an anxious time, and I will be liaising with all the children's new teachers, to help make the move as smooth as possible. The Reception teachers for the children who are leaving us will be visiting Nursery to speak to myself and meet the children. Most schools will be inviting the children for a visit to meet their new teacher and class. The children who are continuing at Yarlside will be meeting their new teacher and spending the morning in Reception on our 'move up' day.

Nursery Snack

The snack money for this half term is £5. Please send it into school in a named envelope.

Nursery do take part in Ice-pop Friday but instead of sending 20p in each week, we will be using some of the children's snack money to buy our own Ice pops and other cold treats as part of the daily snack the money is used for.

Sunhats and Caps

Please make sure your child has a sunhat or cap in school everyday. Also if your child has short hair please make sure that their hat covers the top of their ears, as these do burn easily. We also advise that the children come to Nursery everyday with a high factor sun cream all ready applied. This should last most of the session but the children can bring in their own sun cream to 'top' up during the day. Please label it clearly with their name. For

health and practical reasons the children need to apply their sun cream themselves. Please spend time showing your child how to do this. We will supervise them, however they do need to apply the cream themselves.

Water

The children have access to water to drink throughout their session, however, if they would like to bring their own water bottles in they can do. We do stipulate that it only contains water and not juice, and that the bottle is clearly named and identifiable to your child.

Thank you for your continued support this year. It has been a pleasure and a privilege to have been your child's teacher this year.
