Year 5 "Secondary Experience" Day - Ulverston Victoria High School March 2018

During the week beginning 5th March, we are opening the doors of UVHS to complete Year 5 classes from local primary schools to come on a "Secondary Experience" day at Ulverston Victoria High School. We would therefore like to invite your child to spend a day here to give them a taste of the lessons and facilities we have on offer. It has been agreed with your Headteacher that you can visit UVHS on **Monday 5th March 2018**.

There will be a wide range of lessons that your child may experience, such as Science, Technology, ICT, English, Music or even a session on the climbing wall and all pupils should be equipped with a full pencil case (including a pen, pencil, rubber and ruler).

If your child would like to experience a secondary school lunch in our fantastic canteen then they should bring £2.20 with them (in exact change) which can then be exchanged for a meal voucher – this can be used to get a hot or cold main meal, a cake or biscuit, some fruit and a drink. Alternatively, your child could bring a packed lunch with them.

Please arrange to have your child dropped off at their primary school at 8.10am when a coach will bring the class through to Ulverston in time for the start of school at 8.50am. The pupils will then start with an assembly in the hall followed by six lessons, each lasting 50 minutes. The day will finish at 3.25 pm when your child will get back on the coach and return to their primary school in time to be collected at about 3.55pm.

All classes will have Year 7 mentors with them throughout the day (former students of their own primary school), and pupils will also have the opportunity to meet a number of staff members during the day who will explain the workings of the school.

We are sure that this will prove to be a really interesting and exciting day for the children, providing them with a first experience of secondary school. If you have any questions about the day please contact us at school.
