$$1 \text{ m} = 100\text{cms}$$

$$\frac{1}{2} \text{ m} = 50 \text{ cms}$$

$$\frac{1}{4} \text{ m} = 25 \text{ cms}$$

$$\frac{3}{4} \text{ m} = 75 \text{ cms}$$

$$1\text{cm} = 10\text{mm}$$

$$1 \text{ Litre} = 1000\text{ml}$$

$$\frac{1}{2} \text{ L} = 500\text{ml}$$

$$\frac{1}{4} \text{ L} = 250 \text{ ml}$$

$$\frac{3}{4} \text{ L} = 750 \text{ ml}$$

$$1 \text{ kilogram} = 1000\text{g}$$

$$\frac{1}{2} \text{ kg} = 500\text{g}$$

$$\frac{1}{4} \text{ kg} = 250\text{g}$$

$$\frac{3}{4} \text{ kg} = 750\text{g}$$

$$0.5 = \frac{1}{2}$$

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
